GAMUDA EXPANDS RE FOOTPRINT IN AUSTRALIA WITH 75MW JINBI SOLAR FARM IN WESTERN AUSTRALIA

Petaling Jaya, 11 May 2026

Regional engineering and construction group Gamuda Berhad (Gamuda), through its wholly-owned subsidiary in Australia, DT Infrastructure, is undertaking the delivery of the Jinbi Solar Farm for Yindjibarndi Energy Corporation (YEC), a flagship 75MW project located on Yindjibarndi Ngurra (Country) in Western Australia's Pilbara region, approximately 56 kilometres south of Karratha.

Consisting of 160,000 solar panels, the Jinbi Solar Farm represents a critical milestone in the decarbonisation of the Pilbara region. Once operational, the project will support Rio Tinto's regional power network supporting their operations with sustainable and dependable renewable energy.

DT Infrastructure CEO, John Anderson, noted the project's significance both for the region's energy transition and for DTI's growing renewables portfolio.

"We are proud to partner with YEC on this landmark initiative. This project is not only a vital addition to our renewable energy pipeline but also a testament to our commitment to the Pilbara's future infrastructure," said John.

"Partnering with one of Australia's largest Indigenous-led renewable energy initiatives allows us to support YEC in delivering meaningful, long-term outcomes for the Yindjibarndi community."

The Jinbi Project is one of several major developments being progressed by YEC through its Chichester Range and Eastern Development Zone renewable energy hubs, which together support more than 1.5 gigawatts of wind, solar and battery storage projects in the Pilbara Region.

Craig Ricato, CEO of Yindjibarndi Energy Corporation, welcomed the DT Infrastructure's involvement in the project:

"DT Infrastructure's involvement is a key step in realising our vision for sustainable energy on Yindjibarndi Country. We are excited to work with a partner that shares our commitment to technical excellence and meaningful community outcomes as we move toward our goal of delivering 3GW of renewable capacity in the Pilbara."

Formed in 2023, YEC aims to develop a portfolio of up to 3 gigawatts of renewable energy capacity within approximately 13,000 square kilometres of Yindjibarndi Ngurra, supporting decarbonisation, electrification and new industries in the Pilbara and delivering enduring economic and social benefits for Yindjibarndi people.

Project mobilisation is progressing, with completion expected in early 2028.

DT Infrastructure continues to establish itself as a leading delivery partner in Australia's clean energy transition, focusing on large-scale infrastructure that paves the way for a sustainable future.

Gamuda has been steadfast in expanding its renewable energy portfolio across the Asia Pacific, including solar, hydro and wind projects. Key projects under DT Infrastructure include **Stage 1 of Marinus Link**, a major undersea and underground electricity and data interconnector between Tasmania and Victoria; **Carmody's Hill Wind Farm**; the **Goulburn River Solar Farm**; and the **Boulder Creek Wind Farm**.
